

WALK TITLE: Gharb Allt Falls

DISTANCE: 4 miles

OS GRID REFERENCE: 188915

LANDRANGER /EXPLORER SHEET: 43 & 44/ 388

Public transport Parking Available. Route way marked Toilet. Moderate walk

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: This is a woodland walk through gradually rising tracks to a very picturesque forest waterfall.

GETTING THERE: There is a bus service to Braemar. You get off at the Invercauld Estate.

Start off from the car park at Keiloch in the Invercauld Estate, head back down to the A93 and cross over into the woods in the other side. There is a path that leads through the woods towards the river. It turns right and follows the river to the Old Bridge of Dee. Cross the bridge and turn left into Ballochbuie Forest.

Follow the land rover track on the left which follows the line of the river to the Glenbeg Burn bridge. From here the track climbs, gradually curving right towards the falls. To reach the falls and enjoy their beauty you turn left at the next junction. As well as the bridge over the falls there are several viewpoints from which you can get super views of them. To return retrace your steps back to the Old Bridge of Dee and on to Keiloch.
