



## **Autumn Walks** **Tuesday 24th and Thursday 26th October 2017**

Sadly we have not been able to formalise a walks programme for the Autumn.

On the two days above you will be very welcome to join Brian Torrance in walking in the Huntly Area.

The walk is open to anyone and Brian is willing to accept a fairly large group. He will do the same walk on each day. There is no charge for this walk.

The walk proposed will begin at 10.00 a.m. in the car park by the Nordic Ski centre, just down from Huntly Castle. From there the route goes through the Castle Hotel grounds, along Marquis Drive up to the B9022 Portsoy road then to Fernie Knowe and on to The Bin of Huntly. You will be returning by the same route. This is a Medium to Strenuous 6 mile walk involving road walking and hill climbing (190m). The tracks on The Bin can be wet and slippy with roots and loose stones to cope with so walking poles are recommended.

Toilets are available across from the Police station or by the Market Street car park. Tea and coffee can be had in Asda or Dean's Shortbread factory as well as in a few cafes in the town centre.
